- **Pablo Picasso was a Spanish artist who helped invent a style called Cubism, which uses geometric shapes to show objects from many different angles at the same time.**
- **During his 'Blue Period', Picasso mostly used shades of blue and green to paint sad or lonely subjects, showing how artists can use colour to express emotions.**
- **Picasso did not always paint realistically; he believed that art should represent how we feel or think about an object, rather than just how it looks in a photograph.**
- **By breaking faces and objects into flat, angular shapes, Picasso changed the way people looked at art, moving away from traditional perspective.**
- **He often experimented with different materials, including clay, bronze, and even recycled items, showing that art can be made from anything around us.**

Did you know? Did you know? Pablo Picasso was a child prodigy! He completed his first oil painting, called 'Le Picador', when he was only eight years old. He went on to create over 50,000 artworks during his long life!
