1. What is an adjective? Give one example. (1 mark)

2. Write two adjectives to describe a sunny day. (1 mark)

3. Choose an adjective from the word bank to describe Pip the caterpillar. Explain why you chose that word. (2 marks)

4. Write a sentence using at least two adjectives to describe a picture of a beach. (3 marks)

5. Imagine you are describing a new friend to someone who has never met them. Write a short paragraph (around 5-7 sentences) using adjectives to describe their appearance, personality, and interests. (5 marks)

6. How can adjectives help us when we are writing stories or describing things? Give one reason. (2 marks)

7. Write a list of three adjectives to describe a historical figure, such as a king or queen. Explain why you chose each word. (4 marks)
