

Describing a Magical Garden

Learning objective: To use adjectives to describe a scene and create a vivid picture in the reader's mind

Use the word bank to help you describe the magical garden in your drawing. Remember to include as many adjectives as you can to make your picture come alive!

Draw: Imagine you are standing in a magical garden filled with wonderful sights, sounds, and smells. Draw what you see, using as many adjectives as you can to bring your picture to life. Remember to include a variety of features such as trees, flowers, water, and a seating area.



Label words: sparkling · vibrant · colourful · tall · ancient · mysterious · beautiful · delicate · fragrant

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a path leading to a magnificent tree. What adjectives would you use to describe the tree?
2. Step 2: Add some flowers to your garden. What colours and shapes would you choose and why?
3. Step 3: Include a body of water in your garden, such as a pond or fountain. How would you describe the sound of the water?
4. Step 4: Draw a bench or seating area. What adjectives would you use to describe the materials used to make the bench?
5. Step 5: Look at your finished drawing and write a short sentence describing the overall atmosphere of

your magical garden.

6. Step 6: Choose one adjective from the word bank and use it to describe something in your garden that you haven't labelled yet.

7. Step 7: Can you think of one more adjective to add to your drawing? What is it and how does it contribute to the overall description of your garden?
