

Apostrophe Adventure with Pip and Nova

Learning objective: To understand the correct use of apostrophes for possession and contractions.

Pip and Nova have created a game to help you learn about apostrophes. Pip will show you the correct sentence, and Nova will give you a list of words with apostrophes. Your job is to match the sentences to the correct word. Some sentences might need more than one word with an apostrophe. Put the word in the correct place to complete the sentence.

Word bank: squirrel's · dog's · cat's · book's · his · it's · they're · don't · we'll · can't

1. 1. Pip found a squirrel's nut in the garden. Match the sentence with the correct word. (2 marks)

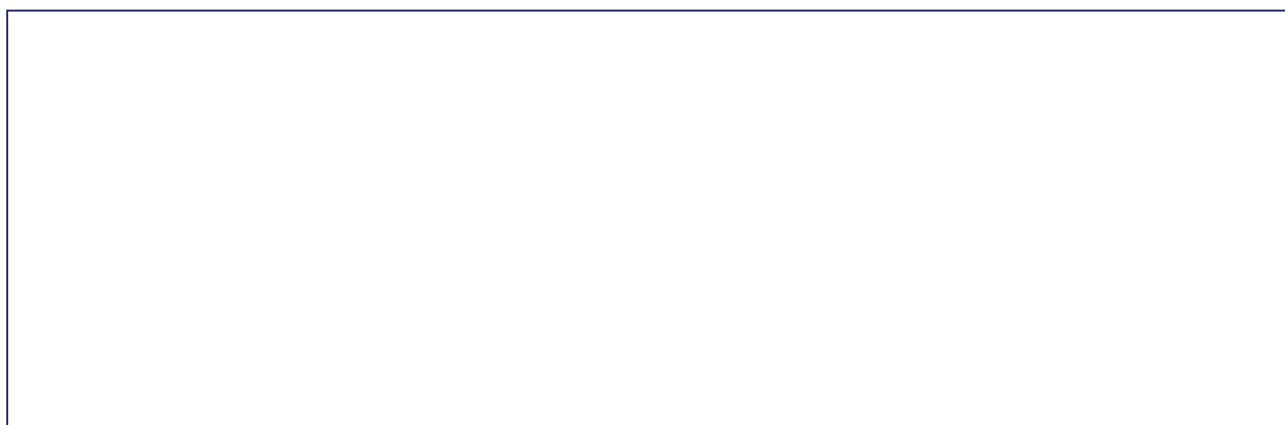
2. 2. Nova's cat's toy is broken. Complete the sentence with the correct word. (2 marks)

3. 3. It's raining today, so we won't go to the park. Fill in the blank with the correct word. (2 marks)

4. 4. Max wants we'll go to the park tomorrow. Complete the sentence with the correct word. (2 marks)

5. 5. Can't fly, but birds can. Fill in the blank with the correct word. (2 marks)
