

Handwriting Adventure with Pip

Learning objective: To practice consistent cursive handwriting, ensuring correct letter formation, spacing, and joining.

Read the story about Pip the caterpillar. Then, rewrite the chosen sentences in your neatest cursive handwriting in the spaces provided, paying close attention to how your letters join together.

Pip is a cheerful bookworm caterpillar who loves collecting beautiful words. Today, Pip found a dusty old diary hidden beneath a giant fern. As Pip read the pages, he noticed that the handwriting was flowing and elegant. The letters danced across the paper, joining together like a little train. Pip decided that he wanted his own writing to be just as clear and graceful. He spent the whole afternoon practising his loops and swirls, making sure every letter sat perfectly on the line.

1. Copy this sentence in your neatest cursive: 'Pip is a cheerful bookworm caterpillar who loves collecting beautiful words.' (2 marks)

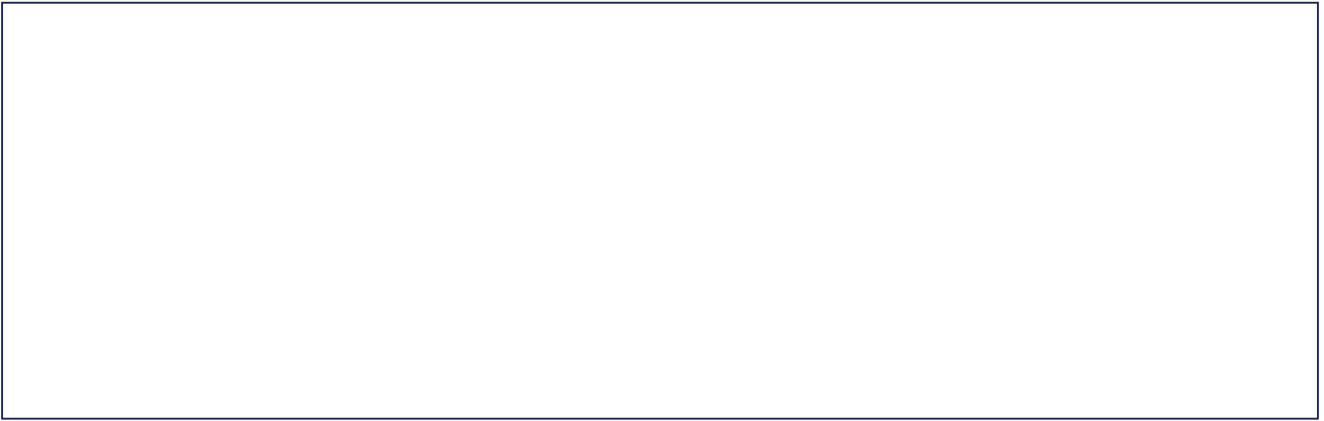
2. Copy this sentence, focusing on the joins: 'The letters danced across the paper, joining together like a little train.' (2 marks)

5. Why do you think it is important for handwriting to be clear and consistent? Write your answer in your best cursive. (3 marks)
