

Nouns and Verbs: Matching Pairs

Learning objective: To identify and match nouns and verbs in simple sentences

Match the words on the left with the words on the right to form complete sentences. Some words will have more than one match, and some words will not be used.

Word bank: kangaroo · jumps · trees · sun · sings · flower · flies · moon · cakes · bakes · time · time · time · time · time

1. What is the noun in the sentence 'Max the monkey jumps high?' (2 marks)

2. What verb describes what the elephant does in the sentence 'Ellie the elephant remembers the history?' (2 marks)

3. Match the noun with the verb in the sentence 'The zebra sees the patterns.' (2 marks)

4. What is the verb in the sentence 'The farmer bakes yummy cakes?' (2 marks)

5. What noun is being described in the sentence 'The sun shines brightly?' (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a scene where you can see some of the words from the activity and label the nouns and verbs in your drawing.



Extension challenge: Write a short story using as many of the nouns and verbs from the activity as you can, making sure to include them correctly in sentences.
