Learning objective: To assess Year 4 students' understanding of nouns and verbs in sentences.

Answer the questions below. Show your work and use the word bank for help when needed.

Max the monkey loves to explore the jungle. He climbs up tall trees and swings from branch to branch. Sometimes he sees other animals, like a friendly squirrel or a curious bird. Max always makes sure to take notes on his adventures using his special notebook. He is very excited to share his findings with his friends back at home.

1. What is a noun? Give two examples from the passage. (2 marks)

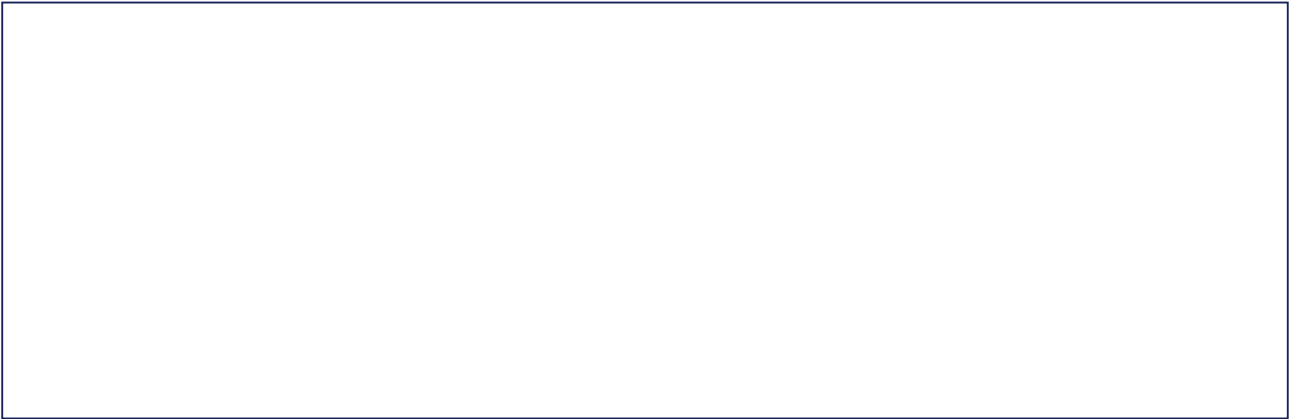
2. What is a verb? Give two examples from the passage. (2 marks)

3. Identify the subject and the object in the sentence: 'Max climbs up tall trees.' (2 marks)

4. Rewrite the sentence 'Sometimes he sees other animals' using a noun that is not in the passage. (2 marks)

5. Identify the verb in the sentence: 'Max is very excited to share his findings.' Explain why you chose this word. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max exploring the jungle. Label the trees, branches, and animals with the correct nouns from the passage.
