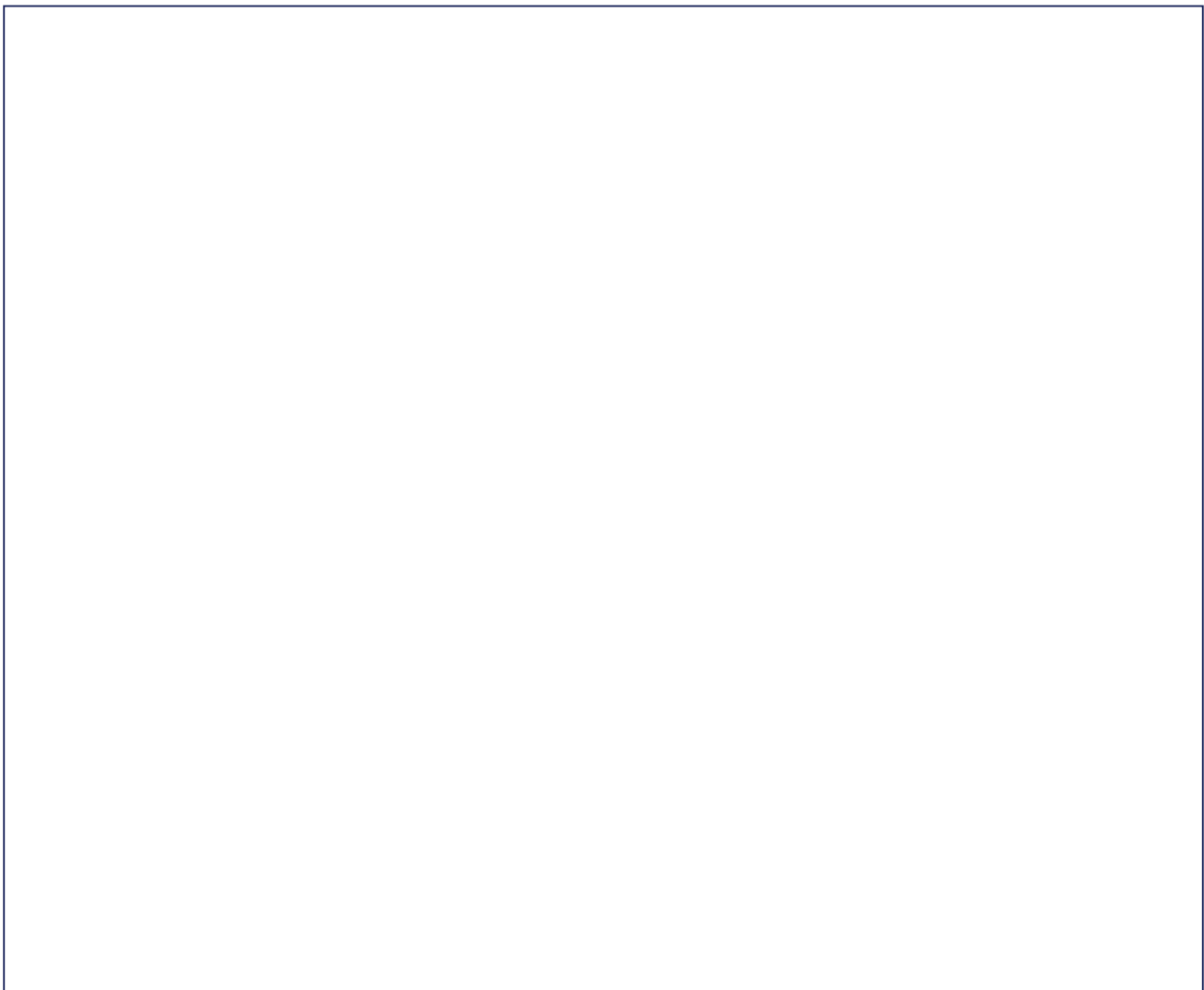


Drawing Sheet: Paragraphs

Learning objective: To understand and represent the structure of a paragraph in a drawing.

Draw a picture that includes the key elements of a paragraph. This includes an introduction (setting the scene), the main body (detailing events or describing something), and a conclusion (summarizing or adding a personal thought).

Draw: Draw a picture of a park on a sunny day. In the introduction (Scene), draw a group of children playing. In the main body (Events), show them having a picnic and playing games. In the conclusion (Conclusion), draw one child writing in a notebook and smiling, summarizing their fun day.



Label words: introduction · main body · conclusion · scene · events · details · summary

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a scene that sets the stage for your paragraph. (Label with 'Scene').
2. Step 2: Draw and label the main events or details that will form the body of your paragraph. (Label with 'Events').
3. Step 3: Draw and label a summary or a personal thought to conclude your paragraph. (Label with 'Conclusion').
