

Persuasive Writing Template: Convince a Friend to Visit the Local Park

Learning objective: To write a persuasive text that uses a range of techniques to convince someone to visit the local park.

Imagine you want to convince your friend to visit the local park with you. Use this template to plan and write your persuasive text. Think about the reasons why your friend should come to the park and what you can say to convince them.

[Introduction]: What is the main reason I want my friend to visit the local park?

Word bank: beautiful · fun · interesting · relaxing · exciting · amazing

1. [Reason 1]: What feature of the park makes it special? (2 marks)

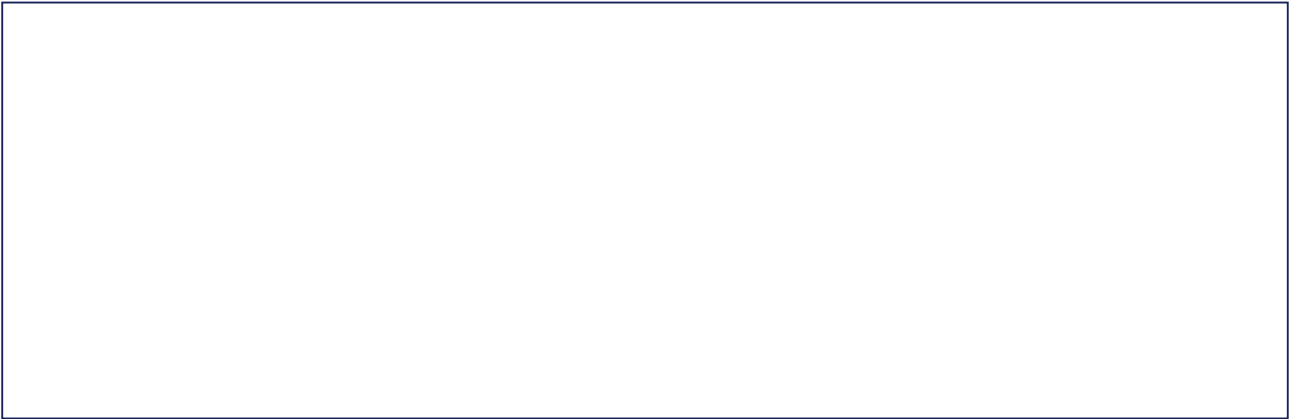
2. [Reason 2]: What activity can we do in the park that my friend will enjoy? (2 marks)

3. [Conclusion]: What will I say to convince my friend to come to the park with me? (2 marks)

4. [Additional reason]: What else can I say to make my friend want to visit the park? (1 mark)

5. [Final plea]: How will I persuade my friend to come to the park with me? (1 mark)

Draw: [Illustrate]: Draw a picture of the local park and what you and your friend can do there.
