

Sentence Structure Worksheet

Learning objective: To understand and identify different types of sentences (statements, questions, and exclamations) and their structures.

This worksheet will help you practice identifying different types of sentences and their structures. Read the passage carefully and answer the questions below. You can use the word bank for help if needed.

Max the monkey is very curious about numbers. He always tries to make everything a math problem. For example, he wonders, 'If I have 5 bananas and give 3 to my friend, how many do I have left? ' He also asks, 'How many leaves are on the tree? ' and exclaims, 'Wow, that's a lot of leaves! '

Word bank: sentence · structure · statement · exclamation · question

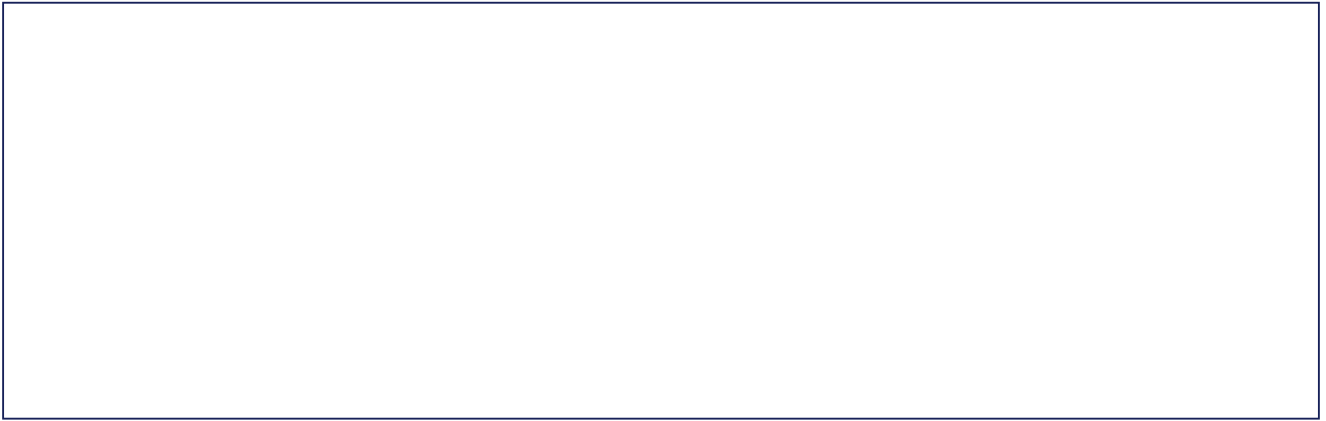
1. Identify the type of sentence and its structure: 'Max the monkey is very curious about numbers.' (2 marks)

2. Identify the type of sentence and its structure: 'For example, he wonders, 'If I have 5 bananas and give 3 to my friend, how many do I have left? '. (Include the quote marks in your answer.) (2 marks)

3. Identify the type of sentence and its structure: 'He also asks, 'How many leaves are on the tree? '. (Include the quote marks in your answer.) (2 marks)

4. Identify the type of sentence and its structure: 'Wow, that's a lot of leaves! ' (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey solving a math problem. What is he counting or calculating?



Extension challenge: Create your own sentence using each type: a statement, a question, and an exclamation. Share them with a friend and ask them to identify the sentence types.
