

Rosa's Animal Adventure: French Vocabulary

Join Rosa the parrot and discover how to name your favourite creatures in French!

- **Le chien** is the French word for a dog. How would you say 'a dog' using the correct article from our word bank?
- **Un oiseau** is a bird. If you see a bird flying in the sky, you can point and say, 'Regarde, un oiseau!'
- **Une tortue** is a tortoise. Remember that 'une' is used because this word is feminine in French.
- **Un chat** is a cat. Rosa the parrot loves to practise saying this word because it is short and fun to say!
- **Un lapin** is a rabbit. You might spot a lapin hopping through a garden on a sunny afternoon.
- **Un poisson** is a fish. Finn the dolphin likes this word, even though he lives in the sea!

Did you know? Did you know? In French, nouns have a gender! We use 'un' for masculine words, like 'un chien', and 'une' for feminine words, like 'une souris'. Looking for the pattern helps you remember them for your French lessons!
