

Rosa's Wardrobe Adventure: French Clothes

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for items of clothing accurately.

Help Rosa the parrot pack for her holiday! Follow the drawing instructions below to create her suitcase scene. Use the word bank to label the items you have drawn in French.

Draw: Draw a bright, colourful scene showing an open suitcase on a bed. Inside the suitcase, neatly arrange a jumper, a shirt, and a pair of trousers. Outside the suitcase, draw a dress, a hat, and a pair of shoes. Ensure your drawing is neat so you have space to add the labels from the word bank next to each item.



Label words: un pull (jumper) · un pantalon (trousers) · une chemise (shirt) · une robe (dress) · des chaussures (shoes) · un chapeau (hat)

Steps:

1. Draw a large open suitcase and inside it, draw 'un pull'. Label it clearly.
2. Draw 'une robe' next to the suitcase. Label it using the French word.
3. Draw a pair of 'des chaussures' at the bottom of the page. Label them.
4. If Rosa is going to a sunny beach, which item from the list would she definitely need to wear on her head? Write the French word.
5. Write a sentence in French describing one item of clothing you have drawn (e.g., 'C'est un pull').
