

Rosa's French Wardrobe Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for common items of clothing and describe what someone is wearing.

Read the clues and use your word bank to help Rosa identify the items of clothing. Practise your French spelling and remember to check if the word needs 'un' or 'une'.

Word bank: un pull (jumper) · une chemise (shirt) · un pantalon (trousers) · une jupe (skirt) · des chaussures (shoes) · un chapeau (hat) · une veste (jacket) · des chaussettes (socks)

1. Rosa is feeling a bit chilly! She decides to put on a warm jumper. Write the French name for this item below. (1 mark)

2. It is a sunny day in the park. Rosa puts on a hat to protect her eyes. What is the French word for hat? (1 mark)

3. Rosa is going to a party. She decides to wear a skirt. Write the French phrase for 'a skirt'. (1 mark)

4. Translate this sentence into English: 'Je porte un pantalon et des chaussures.' (2 marks)

5. If you were going for a walk in the rain, which two items from the word bank would you choose to wear? Write them in French. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw Rosa the parrot wearing her favourite outfit: a colourful jacket (une veste) and a pair of socks (des chaussettes). Label each item in French.



Extension challenge: Write a short sentence in French describing what you are wearing today using the phrase 'Je porte...' (I am wearing...).
