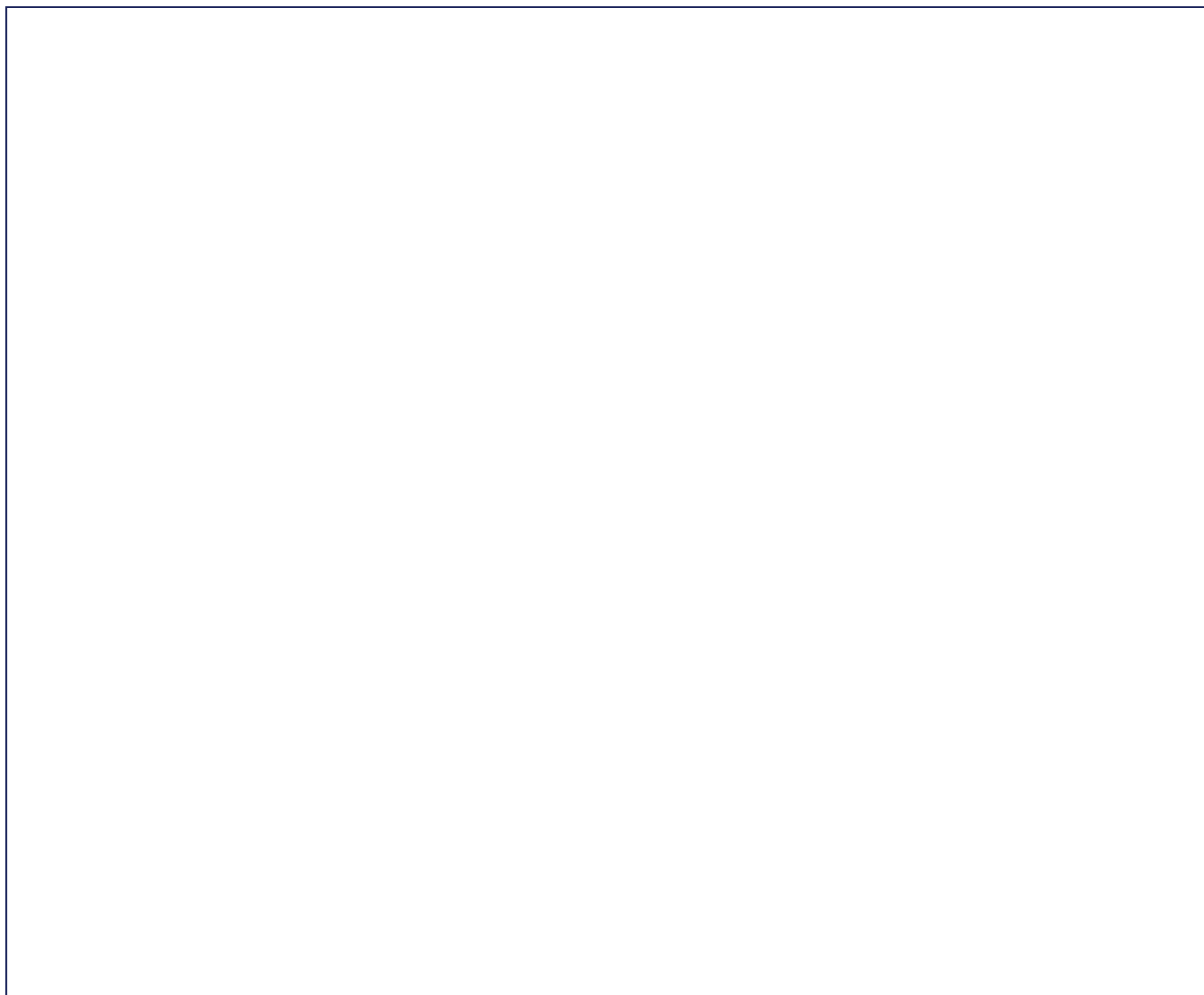


Rosa's Colourful Garden

Learning objective: To identify and use common French vocabulary for colours to describe objects in a garden setting.

Rosa the parrot is visiting a beautiful garden. Use the word bank to label the items you draw in the scene below. Make sure to choose the correct French colour for each object you create!

Draw: Create a vibrant, sunny garden scene. Include a large tree, a patch of flowers, a bright sun in the sky, and perhaps a small garden bird or a butterfly. The style should be clear and open, leaving plenty of space to write your French labels next to the items you have drawn.



Label words: rouge (red) · bleu (blue) · jaune (yellow) · vert (green) · orange (orange) · violet (purple) · rose (pink) · noir (black) · blanc (white)

Steps:

1. Draw a large tree with green leaves and label it using the French word for green.
2. Draw three flowers, each a different colour from the word bank, and label them with their French colour names.
3. Draw a sun in the sky and label it with the correct French colour.
4. If you want to say 'The flower is red' in French, how would you write it? (Hint: Use 'La fleur est...')
5. Choose one object in your drawing and write a full sentence in French to describe its colour.
