

Rosa's Rainbow Art Gallery

Learning objective: To identify, spell, and use French colours to describe objects and express personal preferences.

Rosa the parrot wants to help you create your own French art exhibition! Look at the word bank for help with your spellings. Follow the instructions in each section to complete your gallery guide in French.

Word bank: rouge (red) · bleu (blue) · jaune (yellow) · vert (green) · orange (orange) · violet (purple) · rose (pink) · noir (black) · blanc (white) · C'est... (It is...) · J'aime... (I like...) · Je n'aime pas... (I do not like...)

1. My Favourite Colour: Write a sentence in French explaining which colour is your favourite and why. (2 marks)

2. The Artist's Palette: List three objects you see in your classroom and describe their colour in French (e.g., Le livre est rouge). (3 marks)

3. Colour Mixing: If you mix 'jaune' and 'bleu', what colour do you get? Write the name of the new colour in French. (1 mark)

4. Disliked Colours: Write a sentence in French explaining which colour you do not like and name one thing that is usually that colour. (2 marks)

5. The Rainbow Challenge: Can you name four colours from the rainbow in French? (4 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are painting a portrait of Rosa the parrot. Write three sentences in French describing the colours you would use for her feathers and her beak.
