

Rosa's French Days of the Week Challenge

Learning objective: To learn and apply the vocabulary for the seven days of the week in French.

Join Rosa the parrot as she learns her French! Use the word bank to help you complete the exercises below. Remember, in French, the days of the week do not start with a capital letter unless they are at the start of a sentence.

Word bank: lundi (Monday) · mardi (Tuesday) · mercredi (Wednesday) · jeudi (Thursday) · vendredi (Friday) · samedi (Saturday) · dimanche (Sunday)

1. Rosa is planning her week! If today is 'lundi', what is the French word for the day that comes next (Tuesday)? (1 mark)

2. Write the French words for the two days that make up the weekend. (2 marks)

3. Rosa says: 'Aujourd'hui, c'est mercredi.' What day is it in English? (1 mark)

4. Put these three days in the correct chronological order: vendredi, lundi, mercredi. (2 marks)

5. If you have a maths lesson on 'jeudi' and a swimming lesson on 'vendredi', which day comes first? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot sitting on a branch, holding a sign that shows your favourite day of the week written in French.



Extension challenge: Write a sentence in French starting with 'Le week-end, je...' to describe one activity you enjoy doing on Saturday or Sunday. For example: 'Le week-end, je joue au football.'
