

Year 4 French Assessment: La Nourriture (Food)

Learning objective: To identify, translate, and use French vocabulary related to food and drink, and to express preferences using 'J'aime' and 'Je n'aime pas'.

Read each question carefully. Write your answers in the spaces provided. Rosa the Parrot is here to help you remember your French! Good luck!

Rosa the parrot is having a picnic in the park. She has a basket full of treats. She says: 'J'aime le pain et les fraises. Mais, je n'aime pas le fromage!'

Word bank: une pomme (an apple) · le fromage (cheese) · le pain (bread) · le chocolat (chocolate) · les fraises (strawberries) · le jus d'orange (orange juice) · J'aime (I like) · Je n'aime pas (I do not like)

1. Translate the following foods into English: 1. Une pomme, 2. Le chocolat. (2 marks)

2. Translate the following French phrases into English: 1. J'aime, 2. Je n'aime pas. (2 marks)

3. Based on the passage, what does Rosa like to eat? Write your answer in English. (2 marks)

4. Based on the passage, what does Rosa NOT like to eat? Write your answer in English. (2 marks)

5. Fill in the blanks to complete the sentence: ' _____ le jus d'orange' (I like orange juice). (2 marks)

6. Explain why it is important to know the difference between 'le' and 'la' when ordering food in a French restaurant. (4 marks)

7. Extended Writing Task: Rosa is inviting you to a picnic. Write 4 sentences in French describing what you like and do not like to eat. Use the vocabulary provided in the word bank. (5 marks)

8. If a baguette costs £2 and a punnet of strawberries costs £3, how much would they cost altogether in French? Write the total in words (e.g., cinq livres). (6 marks)
