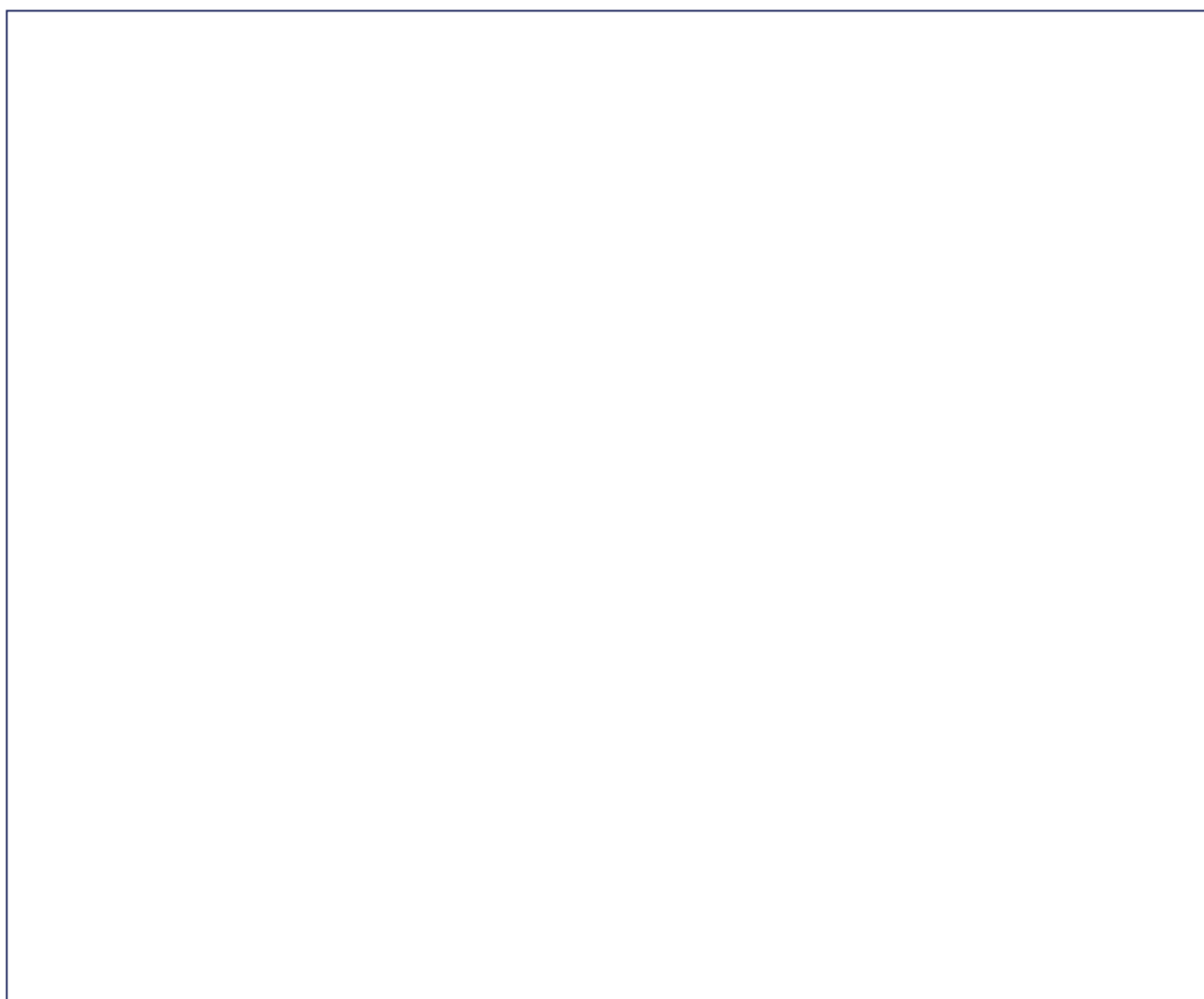


Rosa's French Picnic: Le Pique-Nique

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for common food items and build sentences to describe a picnic scene.

Rosa the parrot is packing her basket for a trip to the park! Follow the drawing prompt to create your own French picnic scene. Use the word bank to label your items and complete the questions to practise your French food vocabulary.

Draw: Draw a sunny park scene featuring a large, checkered picnic blanket on the grass. Draw Rosa the parrot sitting near the blanket. Around Rosa, draw and colour at least five different food items from the word bank. Make the scene look bright and inviting using pencils or felt-tip pens. Ensure every food item you draw is clearly labelled with its French name from the word bank.



Label words: une pomme (an apple) · le fromage (cheese) · le pain (bread) · une banane (a banana) · le chocolat (chocolate) · la salade (salad) · le jus d'orange (orange juice) · le gâteau (cake)

Steps:

1. Draw a large basket in the centre of your page. Inside the basket, draw three items from the word bank. Label them in French.
2. Rosa wants to eat something sweet. Which item from the word bank would she choose? Write the name in

French.

3. If you were going on a picnic, what would you bring? Write one item in French and one in English.
4. Write the phrase 'J'aime...' (I like...) followed by your favourite food from the word bank.
5. Write the phrase 'Je n'aime pas...' (I do not like...) followed by one food item from the list.
