- To say you enjoy a hobby, start your sentence with 'J'aime'. For example, 'J'aime dessiner' means 'I like to draw'.
- If you do not enjoy a hobby, you can say 'Je n'aime pas'. For example, 'Je n'aime pas le vélo' means 'I do not like cycling'.
- The word 'jouer' means 'to play'. Remember to use 'jouer au' before a sport like 'jouer au football'.
- When talking about hobbies like swimming, we often use 'la' or 'le'. We say 'la natation' for swimming.
- Practise your pronunciation by saying these hobbies aloud with a friend to build your confidence in French!

Did you know? Did you know? In France, many children enjoy 'le judo' as an after-school hobby! It is very popular and a great way to stay active and learn discipline.
