

Rosa's French Number Garden

Learning objective: To identify, write, and use French numbers from 1 to 20 in a creative context.

Follow the drawing prompt to create your French Number Garden. Use the word bank to label your items and answer the questions below to show off your French skills!

Draw: Draw a colourful garden scene. Include: 1 large sun in the corner, 2 tall trees, 3 friendly bees buzzing around, 10 colourful flowers in a row, and 15 fluffy clouds in the sky. Use bright, cheerful colours. Label each group of items with the correct French number word from the word bank provided.



Label words: un (1) · deux (2) · trois (3) · quatre (4) · cinq (5) · dix (10) · quinze (15) · vingt (20)

Steps:

1. Rosa the parrot wants to count her feathers. If she has 'dix' blue feathers and 'cinq' green feathers, how many does she have in total? Write the number in French.
2. Draw 4 apples in your garden. Label them using the correct French word from the word bank.
3. If you have 'trois' butterflies and you add 'deux' more, what is the new total in French?
4. Write the French word for the number 20.
5. Look at your drawing. Choose one group of objects you have drawn and write a sentence in French, e.g., 'J'ai [number] [object]'.
