

Rosa's Wonderful World of French Numbers

Count along with Rosa the Parrot and master your French numbers!

- Zero to five in French are: zéro, un, deux, trois, quatre, and cinq.
- Six to ten are: six, sept, huit, neuf, and dix.
- Eleven to fifteen are: onze, douze, treize, quatorze, and quinze.
- Sixteen to twenty are: seize, dix-sept, dix-huit, dix-neuf, and vingt.
- Remember: 'Dix-sept' is just 'ten' (dix) plus 'seven' (sept) joined by a hyphen!
- Practise your pronunciation by saying the numbers aloud to a partner.

Did you know? Did you know? In French, the number 10 is 'dix' and the number 11 is 'onze'. Many French numbers sound a little bit like English ones because the languages have shared history! Can you spot the similarity between 'sept' and the English word 'seven'?
