5. True or False: The number 10 in French is spelled 'neuf'. (1 mark)

6. Write the number digit that corresponds to the French word 'treize'. (1 mark)

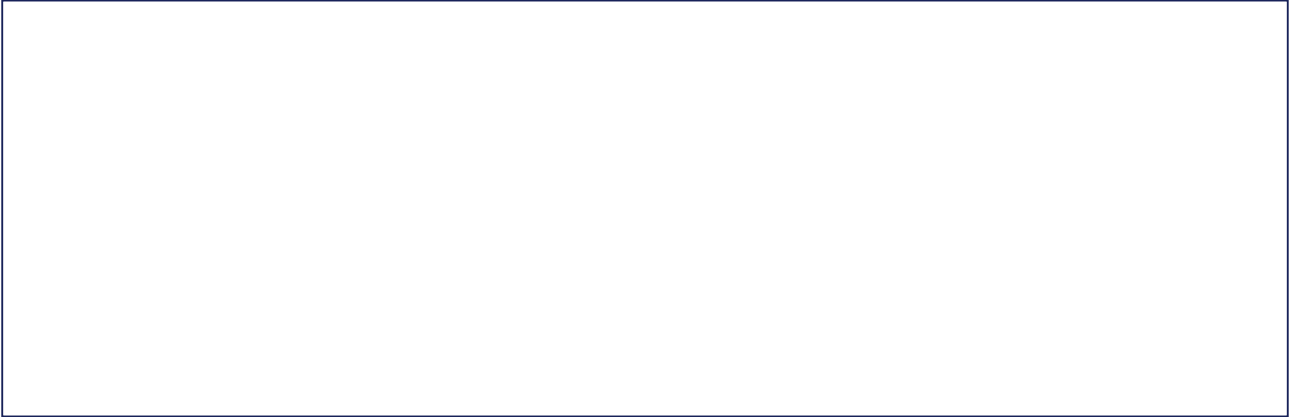
7. What is the French word for 20? A) Vingt* B) Dix-neuf C) Douze D) Huit (1 mark)
