

Ma Journée à l'École - Year 4 French Assessment

Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of school subjects, classroom items, and simple opinions in French.

Read each question carefully. Write your answers in French or English as requested. Ensure your spelling is accurate.

Rosa the parrot is flying around the classroom. She observes the children working. 'J'aime les maths!' says a student. 'C'est amusant.' Another student says, 'Je n'aime pas le sport, mais j'aime l'art.' They are all using their pens and rubbers in their books.

Word bank: le français (French) · les maths (Maths) · l'art (Art) · la géographie (Geography) · le sport (PE) · j'aime (I like) · je n'aime pas (I do not like) · le stylo (pen) · le cahier (exercise book) · la gomme (rubber)

1. Translate the following school subjects into English: 1) Le sport, 2) Les maths. (2 marks)

2. Based on the passage, why does the first student like Maths? (2 marks)

3. Write a French sentence to say: 'I like Geography'. (2 marks)

4. Identify two items mentioned in the passage that the students are using. Write them in French. (2 marks)

5. Rosa is helping a student pack their school bag. If a pen costs £2 and a rubber costs £1, how much do they cost altogether? Write the total in words in French (e.g., trois livres). (3 marks)

6. Explain why it is important to learn different school subjects. Give one reason in English. (4 marks)

7. Extended Writing: Write a short paragraph (3-5 sentences) in French describing your favourite subject and one subject you do not like. Use 'J'aime' and 'Je n'aime pas'. (10 marks)

Draw: Draw your favourite subject at school and label at least two items you use in that lesson using French vocabulary.
