

Rosa's Classroom Adventures: French School Vocabulary

Learning objective: To learn and apply French vocabulary related to school subjects and classroom objects.

Help Rosa the parrot learn about school! Use the word bank to help you translate the sentences and answer the questions below.

Word bank: le français - French · les maths - maths · l'histoire - history · la géographie - geography · le crayon - pencil · le cahier - notebook · la trousse - pencil case · j'aime - I like · je n'aime pas - I do not like

1. Rosa is looking at your desk. Write the French word for 'pencil' and 'notebook' in your best handwriting. (2 marks)

2. If you enjoy counting numbers and solving problems, which subject would you say you like? Use the sentence starter: 'J'aime...' (2 marks)

3. Translate this sentence into English: 'Je n'aime pas la géographie.' (2 marks)

4. You are packing your bag for school. If you have a pencil case, a notebook, and a pencil, write them in French. (3 marks)

5. Choose one school subject you study in Year 4. Write a French sentence to tell Rosa if you like it or not. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your ideal school desk. Label the pencil (le crayon) and the notebook (le cahier) using the correct French words.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are a teacher for a day. Write down two more school subjects you know in English and try to find their French translations using a dictionary or your classroom resources.
