

Rosa's French Time Challenge

Learning objective: To be able to tell the time in French using the 12-hour clock (o'clock and half past).

Rosa the parrot is practising her French! Look at the clocks showing different times throughout the day. Match the French phrase from the word bank to the correct time shown on each clock face. Write the English translation next to it to show you understand what Rosa is saying.

Word bank: Il est une heure · Il est deux heures · Il est cinq heures · Il est huit heures · Il est dix heures et demie · Il est midi

1. 1. Clock shows 1:00. Write the French phrase and the English translation. (2 marks)

2. 2. Clock shows 2:00. Write the French phrase and the English translation. (2 marks)

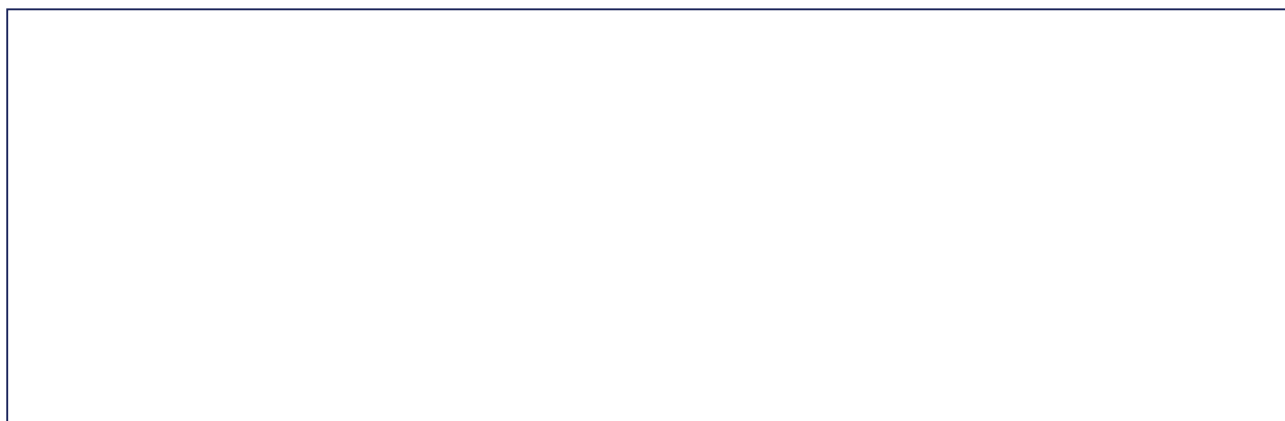
3. 3. Clock shows 5:00. Write the French phrase and the English translation. (2 marks)

4. 4. Clock shows 8:00. Write the French phrase and the English translation. (2 marks)

5. 5. Clock shows 10:30. Write the French phrase and the English translation. (2 marks)

6. 6. Clock shows 12:00 (midday). Write the French phrase and the English translation. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a clock face showing 'Il est quatre heures' and colour the clock hands bright yellow like Rosa's feathers.



Extension challenge: Rosa wants to learn how to say 'quarter past' (et quart). Research how to say 'quarter past' in French and write a sentence about what time you eat your dinner using that phrase.
