2. Climate: Describe the weather in a rainforest. What is it like in terms of temperature and rain? (3 marks)

3. The Forest Layers: Explain the difference between the canopy layer and the forest floor. (4 marks)

4. Amazing Adaptations: Choose one rainforest animal or plant. How does it survive in this environment? (3 marks)

5. Why Rainforests Matter: Why are rainforests important for the rest of the planet? (3 marks)

6. Threats to the Forest: What is deforestation, and why is it a problem for the animals living there? (4 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you research and list three different countries that contain tropical rainforests?
