

Discovering the UK Regions

Learning objective: To understand and identify the main regions of the United Kingdom.

Use a pencil, coloured pencils, or markers to draw a map of the UK Regions. Label the regions and add features that are unique to each area.

Draw: Imagine you are on a road trip around the UK. Draw a colourful map of the four main regions: England, Scotland, Wales, and Northern Ireland. Add mountains, coastlines, rivers, and famous landmarks to make your map come alive. You can include roads, signs, and even some of your favourite foods from each region!



Label words: England · Scotland · Wales · Northern Ireland · Mountains · Coastline · Rivers

Steps:

1. Draw a map of the UK and label the four main regions.
2. What is the largest region in the UK?
3. Add mountains to the region of Scotland.
4. Label a major river in Wales.
5. Draw a picture of a famous landmark in Northern Ireland.
