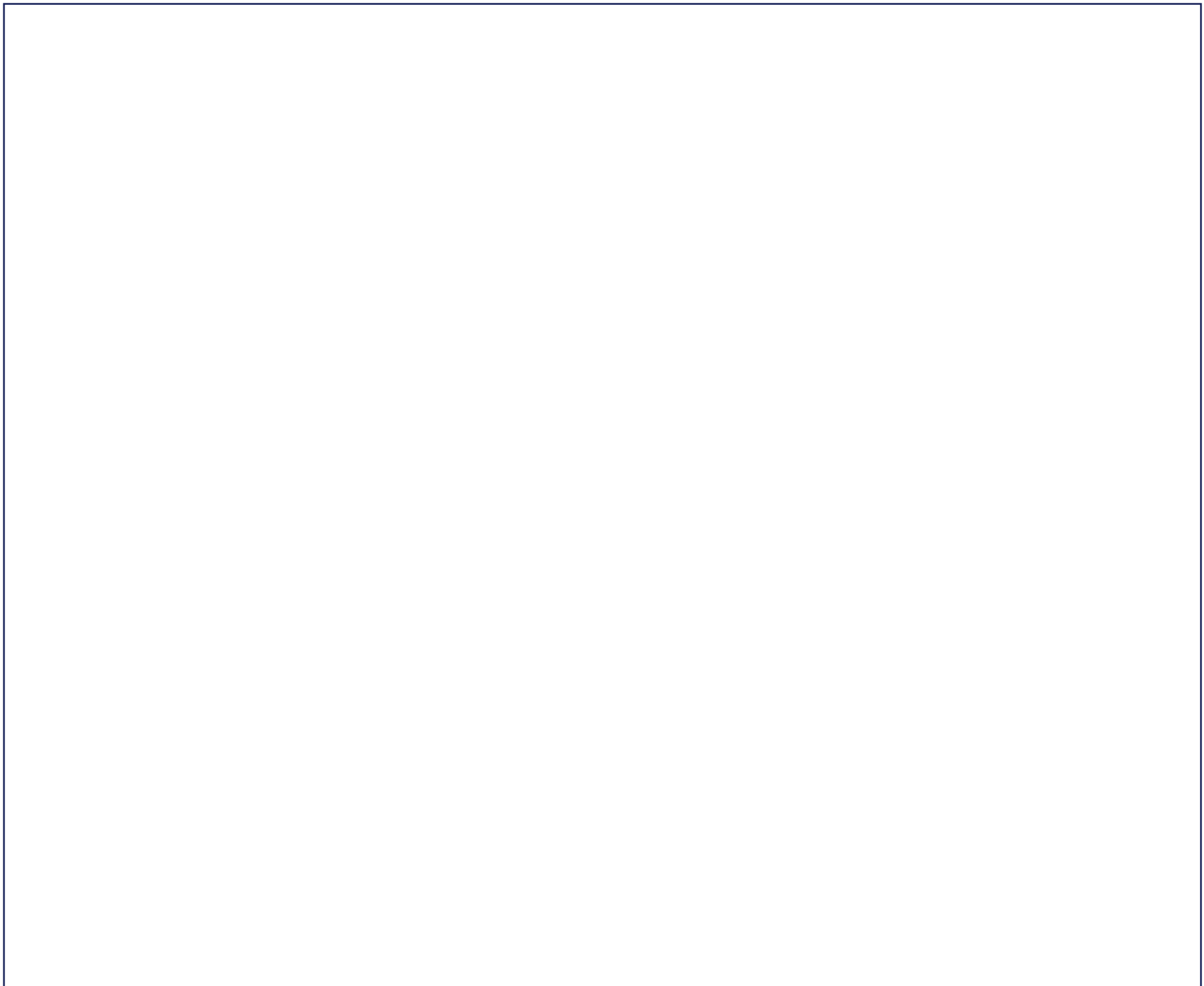


Exploring Ancient Greece with Ellie the Elephant

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate key features of Ancient Greek architecture and daily life.

Use your knowledge of Ancient Greece to complete the drawing below. Make sure to label your artwork using the words provided in the word bank.

Draw: Draw a busy scene from an Ancient Greek city-state. In the centre, draw Ellie the Elephant standing in a marketplace. In the background, draw a grand temple like the Parthenon. Use clear lines and bright colours to show the stone architecture and the people dressed in chitons. Ensure there is space to add labels for the temple, the columns, the market, the clothing, and an olive tree.



Label words: Parthenon · Chiton · Olive Tree · Column · Agora

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large temple in the background with tall stone pillars. Label the pillars as a 'Column'.
2. Step 2: Draw Ellie wearing a traditional Greek tunic. Label this clothing as a 'Chiton'.
3. Step 3: Draw a marketplace area in front of the temple where people are trading. Label this place the 'Agora'.
4. Step 4: Draw a tree near the temple entrance and label it an 'Olive Tree'.
5. Step 5: Write one sentence explaining why the 'Agora' was an important part of life in Ancient Greece.
