

Addition with Pip and Max

Learning objective: To practice and apply addition with two-digit numbers.

Use the addition problems provided to practice your maths skills. You can use the word bank to help you. Draw a picture of Pip and Max solving one of the problems in your template.

Pip the caterpillar and Max the monkey are having a picnic in the meadow. Pip has 15 cookies and Max has 23 cookies. They want to know how many cookies they have together. Can you help them find out?

Word bank: add · to · sum · plus · equals · total · two-digit · numbers

1. What is 15 plus 23? (2 marks)

2. If Pip gives 5 cookies to Max, how many cookies do they have together? (2 marks)

3. Max has 48 cookies and Pip has 32 cookies. How many cookies do they have altogether? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw Pip and Max sharing their cookies. What are they saying to each other?



Extension challenge: Can you create your own addition problem for Pip and Max to solve? Write it down in the space provided and solve it.
