Learning objective: To practise estimating, calculating, and solving problems involving money in Australian dollars and cents.

Read the front of the card to test your knowledge of money. Flip the card in your mind to check the answer. See if you can solve the maths puzzles Max has left for you!

How many pence are in £1?	If Max has £5.00 and spends £2.50, how much change should he receive?
100 pence	£2.50
Write £4 and 75p as a decimal.	Pip buys a bookmark for £1.20 and a notepad for £2.30. What is the total cost?
£4.75	£3.50
True or False: £0.50 is the same as 50p.	Ellie has a £10 note. She buys a book for £6.20. How much change does she get?
True	£3.80
Zara wants to buy three paintbrushes that cost £1.10 each. How much will they cost in total?	What is the smallest number of coins needed to make 60p?
£3.30	Two coins (a 50p and a 10p)
If you round £4.89 to the nearest pound, what do you get?	Kit has two £2 coins and three 20p coins. How much money does he have altogether?
£5.00	£4.60
You have £2.00. You spend £1.45. How much is left?	Which is greater: £2.05 or £2.50?
55p	£2.50
