

## Track Sheet - Times Tables

*Learning objective: To recall and use multiplication facts for the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, and 10 times tables confidently.*

Complete the following questions to show your understanding of the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, and 10 times tables.

Max the monkey is planning a big party. He needs to arrange chairs in groups for his friends. He wants to use the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, and 10 times tables to help him.

*Word bank: times · table · multiply · equal · groups*

**1. What is 4 times 3? (2 marks)**

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**2. What is 10 times 2? (2 marks)**

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**3. If Max arranges 5 groups of 8 chairs, how many chairs will there be in total? (2 marks)**

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**4. What is 8 times 5? (2 marks)**

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**Draw: Draw a picture of Max arranging chairs in groups for his party. Use the times tables to count the chairs in each group.**



*Extension challenge: Can you write the inverse calculation for 10 times 2? (Hint: What is 2 plus what number equals 20?)*
