Learning objective: To recognise and celebrate the diversity of people in our community and understand why it is important to include everyone.

Use this fact-file to explore what makes people unique. Think about how our different backgrounds, interests, and personalities make our school and local community a more interesting and special place to be. Follow the prompts to complete each section.

5. Reflecting on Diversity: If everyone in the world were exactly the same, what would we lose? Explain your thoughts. (2 marks)
