

Kindness in Our Community

Learning objective: To understand how kind actions contribute to a happy and supportive community by illustrating examples of empathy and cooperation.

Use the space provided to create a scene showing acts of kindness. Follow the drawing steps carefully and use the word bank to label your picture.

Draw: Draw a vibrant scene set in a park. Include Max the monkey and at least two other BookFlik characters. The style should be clear and cheerful, using bright colours. Ensure the characters are interacting in ways that show care, such as sharing, helping, or listening. Include a small 'kindness tree' in the background with leaves that have the words from the word bank written on them.



Label words: Empathy · Cooperation · Support · Inclusion · Friendship · Respect

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw Max the monkey sharing his lunch with a friend who forgot theirs. Label the emotion on their faces.
2. Step 2: Draw two other BookFlik characters working together to solve a difficult maths puzzle. Label the word 'Cooperation'.
3. List one kind thing you could do at school this week to help someone feel included.

4. Why is it important to show kindness even when no one is watching?
5. Look at your drawing. Which word from the word bank best describes your scene and why?
