

Kit's Guide to Being a Digital Explorer

Learning objective: To identify how to stay safe online and understand the importance of keeping personal information private.

Use your pencils and colours to complete the drawing activity. Follow the steps below to build your own 'Digital Shield' scene.

Draw: Draw a large, colourful shield in the centre of the page. Inside the shield, draw Kit the fox using a tablet. Surround the shield with symbols of safety: a padlock to represent passwords, a speech bubble showing someone talking to a 'Trusted Adult', and a 'Report' button. Use bright colours to show that being safe online is a positive and smart choice.



Label words: Privacy · Password · Trusted Adult · Kindness · Report · Personal Information

Steps:

1. Why is it important to keep your home address and school name private when you are online?
2. If you see something online that makes you feel worried or sad, what is the first thing you should do?
3. Label the part of your drawing that shows a 'Trusted Adult' who you can talk to about your online activity.
4. Think of a strong password. Why should you never share it with anyone except your parents or carers?
5. What does it mean to be 'kind' online? Give one example of a positive action you can take when chatting or gaming.
