

Celebrating Eid: A Festive Drawing Activity

Learning objective: To identify and represent key traditions and symbols associated with Eid celebrations in the Muslim community.

Help Max the monkey celebrate Eid! Use the drawing prompt to create a festive scene. Once you have finished your drawing, use the word bank to label the different parts of your picture and answer the questions below to show what you know about this special time.

Draw: Draw a vibrant scene of an Eid celebration. In the background, draw a beautiful mosque with a crescent moon and star on top. In the foreground, draw a table filled with festive foods and sweets. Include a group of happy friends and family members wearing colourful new clothes, sharing gifts and greeting each other. Make sure to leave space to label your drawing using the word bank!



Label words: Mosque · Prayer Mat · Eid Mubarak · Dates · New Clothes · Family · Gifts

Steps:

2. Why do many people wear new or their best clothes on Eid?
3. What is the name of the building where many Muslims gather for the special Eid prayer?
4. Eid al-Fitr happens at the end of which holy month of fasting?

5. Aside from prayer, name one way families enjoy spending time together during Eid.
6. If Max bought a small gift for a friend for £4.50 and a box of dates for £3.20, how much did he spend in total?
