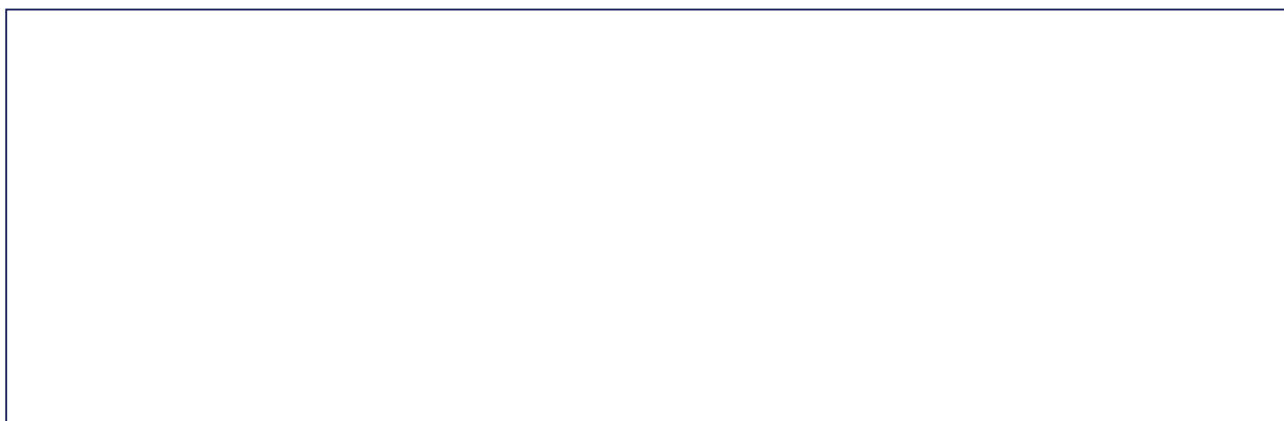
4. Fasting: Abstaining from food and drink during daylight hours in the month of Ramadan. Pillar: _____
