- A Church is a place of worship for Christians, often featuring a cross and a pulpit for preaching.
- A Mosque is a sacred place for Muslims, where the architecture often includes a dome and a minaret.
- A Synagogue is where Jewish people gather for prayer and to read the Torah.
- A Mandir is a place of worship for Hindus, often containing beautiful statues of deities called murtis.
- A Gurdwara is the place of worship for Sikhs, and it always has a community kitchen called a langar.
- A sacred space is a place that is treated with great respect because it is dedicated to a spiritual purpose.

Did you know? Did you know that some places of worship have very specific rules about footwear? For example, in a Mosque, people remove their shoes before entering the prayer hall to keep the sacred space clean and pure!
