

Rosa's Wardrobe Adventure: Spanish Clothes Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and use common Spanish vocabulary for clothing and colours, and to apply them in simple descriptive sentences.

Rosa the parrot is getting ready for a sunny holiday! Look at the clothes in her suitcase listed in the word bank. Match the Spanish word to the correct English translation, then use the sentence builder to describe what Rosa is packing.

Word bank: la camiseta (t-shirt) · los pantalones (trousers) · el sombrero (hat) · las gafas de sol (sunglasses) · el vestido (dress) · los zapatos (shoes) · la chaqueta (jacket) · azul (blue) · rojo (red) · amarillo (yellow)

1. 1. Translate: Match the Spanish clothing item to the English meaning. (4 marks)

2. 2. Rosa has a red t-shirt. Write this in Spanish: 'Rosa tiene una camiseta...' (2 marks)

3. 3. Rosa has blue trousers. Write this in Spanish: 'Rosa tiene unos pantalones...' (2 marks)

4. 4. If Rosa packs 'el sombrero amarillo', what is she packing in English? (2 marks)

5. 5. Why do you think Rosa needs 'las gafas de sol' for her holiday? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw Rosa the parrot wearing her favourite holiday outfit. Label at least three items of clothing in Spanish (e.g., draw a hat and label it 'el sombrero').



Extension challenge: Write a short sentence in Spanish describing your own favourite item of clothing using the structure: 'Me gusta mi...' (I like my...).
