

Rosa's Sunny Day Wardrobe

Learning objective: To read and understand a short text in Spanish about clothes and describe outfits using basic vocabulary.

Read the text carefully. Use the word bank to help you understand the Spanish phrases. Answer the questions in English.

¡Hola! Soy Rosa la lora. Today is a beautiful day at the park. Because hace sol, I am choosing my clothes very carefully. I am wearing my favourite yellow camiseta and comfortable blue pantalones. When the sun is very bright, I always wear my big, colourful sombrero to keep me cool. I also have my favourite pair of stylish gafas de sol. My friend Kit the fox is also at the park today. He is wearing a green jacket because he likes to be ready for anything, but I think he is a bit too hot! I love choosing my clothes each morning. La ropa is a wonderful way to show how you feel. Whether it is a sunny day or a rainy day, picking the right outfit is always a fun adventure. Do you like choosing your clothes? I think my yellow camiseta makes me feel very happy and bright, just like the sunshine. What is your favourite thing to wear when you go outside to play with your friends?

1. What two items of clothing is Rosa wearing that are mentioned in the text? (2 marks)

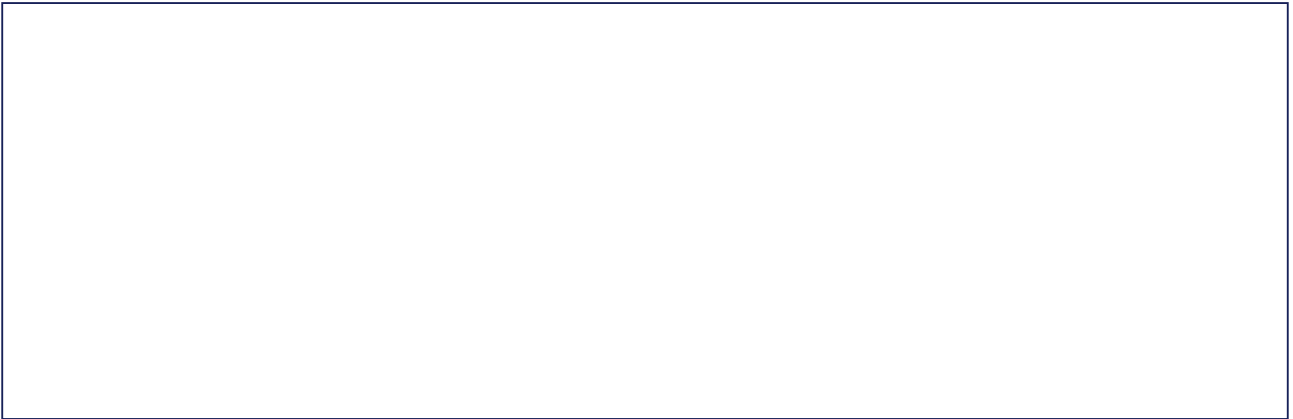
2. Why does Rosa decide to wear a sombrero and gafas de sol? (2 marks)

3. Why does the author suggest that Kit the fox might be feeling uncomfortable? (2 marks)

4. How does Rosa feel about her choice of clothes, and what evidence supports this? (2 marks)

5. Do you agree with Rosa that choosing clothes is a fun adventure? Explain your answer. (2 marks)
