

Rosa's Spanish Wardrobe

Learning objective: To identify and use vocabulary for common items of clothing in Spanish.

Read each question carefully and use your knowledge of Spanish vocabulary to answer. Remember to check your spelling!

Rosa the parrot is getting ready for a sunny day of teaching in the park. She needs to pick the right outfit for the weather!

Word bank: la camiseta (t-shirt) · los pantalones (trousers) · los zapatos (shoes) · el jersey (jumper) · la chaqueta (jacket) · el vestido (dress) · la falda (skirt) · el sombrero (hat)

1. Rosa is feeling a bit chilly. Which item from the word bank should she put on to stay warm? Write the Spanish word. (1 mark)

2. If Rosa wants to wear a skirt, which Spanish word should she use? Write the word and include the correct article (la/el). (1 mark)

3. Translate the following sentence into English: 'Yo llevo los zapatos.' (2 marks)

4. Max the monkey wants to go for a walk. Write a Spanish sentence to say 'I am wearing trousers' using the word bank. (2 marks)

5. If you were going to the beach, which two items from the word bank might you need? Explain your choice in one English sentence. (3 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot wearing a colourful hat (el sombrero) and a jumper (el jersey). Label the items in Spanish.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are packing a suitcase for a holiday. Write a list of 5 items of clothing you would take in Spanish, and estimate the cost of each item in pounds (£) to practise your maths skills!
