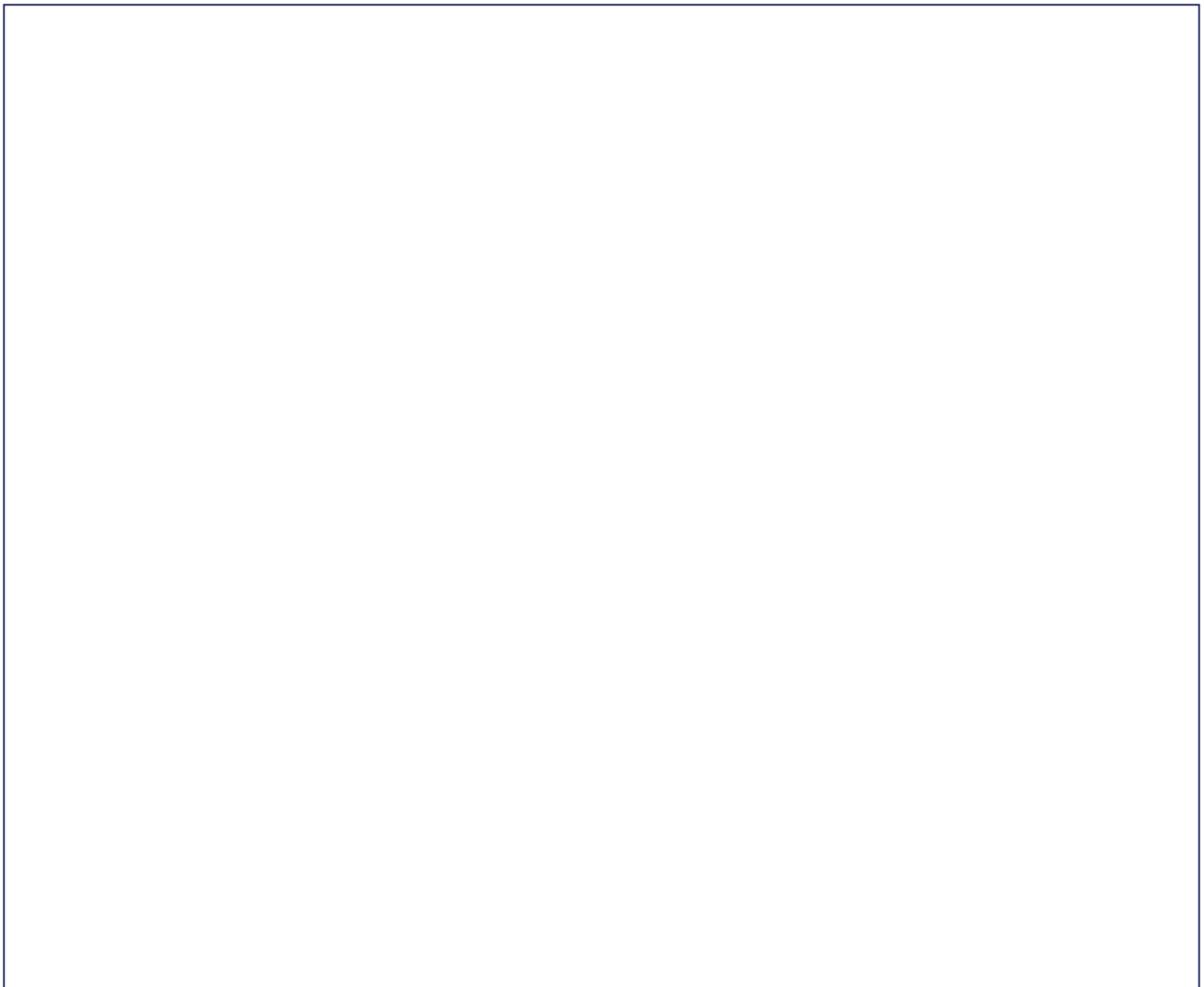


Rosa's Colourful Garden

Learning objective: To recall and use Spanish vocabulary for common colours to describe objects in a garden scene.

Rosa the parrot is painting a beautiful garden! Read the Spanish words in the word bank and draw the items in the garden scene. Make sure to colour them in correctly according to their Spanish names.

Draw: Create a landscape scene of a garden. Include a large space for the sky at the top, a grassy area at the bottom, and space for flowers and a birdbath in the centre. Use a clear, simple artistic style with bold outlines so that the colours can be easily identified.



Label words: rojo (red) · azul (blue) · amarillo (yellow) · verde (green) · naranja (orange) · morado (purple)

Steps:

1. Draw a bright sun in the sky and label it 'amarillo'.
2. Draw three flowers on the ground. Make one 'rojo', one 'morado', and one 'naranja'.
3. Draw a birdbath filled with water. Colour the water 'azul' and label it.
4. Draw some long grass at the bottom of your picture and colour it 'verde'.
5. Which colour is 'rojo' in English?
