

Mi Familia - Rosa's Spanish Family Fact-File

Learning objective: To use Spanish vocabulary to describe family members and their names, as required for Year 4 Modern Foreign Languages.

Rosa the parrot is helping you create a fact-file about your family! Use the word bank to help you complete each section in Spanish. Write the name of your family member, their Spanish title, and one thing you like doing together.

Word bank: madre (mum) · padre (dad) · hermano (brother) · hermana (sister) · abuelo (grandad) · abuela (gran) · tío (uncle) · tía (aunt) · Me gusta jugar con... · Es muy amable.

1. Mi Madre o Mi Padre: Write the name of your parent and their Spanish title here. Describe them using a short sentence. (2 marks)

2. Mi Hermano o Mi Hermana: If you have siblings, write their names here. If you don't, you could write about a cousin (primo/prima). (2 marks)

3. Mis Abuelos: Write the names of your grandparents here. Tell us what you like to do with them in Spanish. (2 marks)

4. Family Activity: Describe one activity you enjoy doing with your family. Use the phrase 'Me gusta...' (I like to...) (2 marks)

5. Extra Fact: Can you name another relative in Spanish? Write their name and who they are to you. (1 mark)

*Extension challenge: Can you write a sentence in Spanish about how many people are in your family?
Example: 'En mi familia hay cuatro personas.'*
