Rosa the parrot is hosting a food festival! She has prepared a table with lots of tasty items. She is asking her friends to say what they like to eat and drink.

1. 1. Translate these two food items into Spanish: Apple and Banana. (2 marks)

2. 2. If you want to say 'I like cheese', how would you write that in Spanish? (2 marks)

3. 3. What is the difference between the verbs 'comer' and 'beber'? Give an example of one item you would 'beber'. (3 marks)

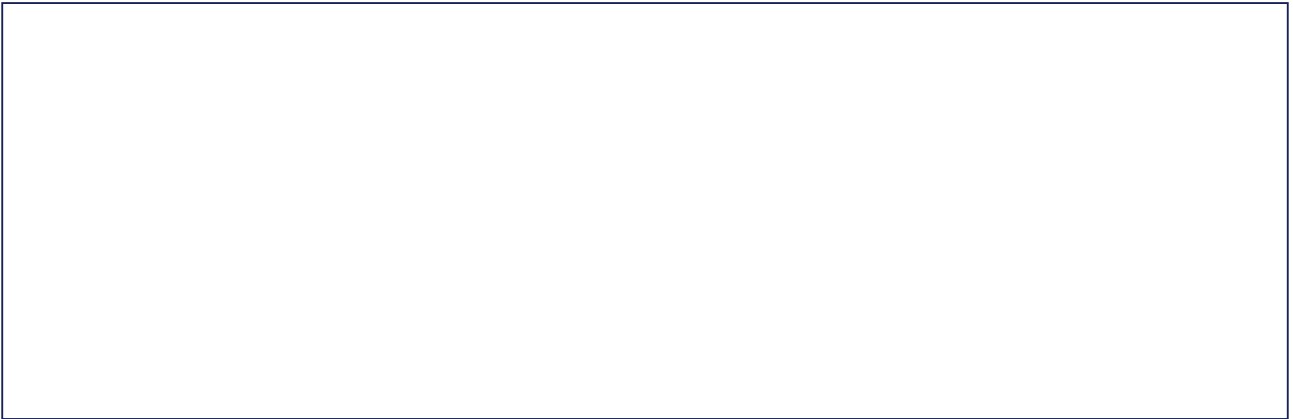
4. 4. Look at the phrase 'No me gusta el pan'. What does this mean in English? (3 marks)

5. 5. Rosa is serving snacks. If an apple costs £1.20 and a piece of bread costs £0.80, how much would they cost altogether in Australian dollars and cents? (4 marks)

6. 6. Imagine you are at the food festival. Write three full sentences in Spanish describing three things you like or dislike. Use 'Me gusta' or 'No me gusta'. (6 marks)

7. 7. Why is it important to know the difference between healthy foods and treats? Write a short explanation. (5 marks)
