

Rosa's School Bag Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish vocabulary related to school subjects and classroom objects.

Rosa the parrot is helping her friends organise their school bags! Look at the list of Spanish words below. Your task is to match the Spanish word to the correct English translation, then write a short sentence in Spanish using the sentence starter provided to say what is in your bag.

Word bank: el estuche (pencil case) · el cuaderno (notebook) · la regla (ruler) · las matemáticas (maths) · el arte (art) · la geografía (geography)

1. Match the word: What is the Spanish word for 'maths'? (1 mark)

2. Match the word: What is the Spanish word for 'ruler'? (1 mark)

3. Match the word: What is the Spanish word for 'notebook'? (1 mark)

4. Complete the sentence: 'En mi mochila tengo...' (In my bag I have...) Choose two items from the word bank to complete your sentence in Spanish. (2 marks)

5. Application: If you wanted to say 'I like art' in Spanish, you would say 'Me gusta el arte'. How would you say 'I like maths' using the word bank? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw your school bag and label three items inside it using the Spanish words you have learned today.



Extension challenge: Rosa wants to know your favourite subject! Write a sentence saying 'Mi asignatura favorita es...' (My favourite subject is...) and explain why in English.
