

Rosa's Spanish Market Adventure

Learning objective: To learn and apply Spanish vocabulary for shopping, prices, and food items in a market context.

Rosa the parrot is visiting a bustling market in Spain! Help her complete her shopping list by matching the Spanish items to their English translations and calculating the total cost of her basket using the prices provided. Then, fill in the blanks in her shopping dialogue.

Word bank: La manzana (apple) · El pan (bread) · El queso (cheese) · La leche (milk) · Dos euros (£2.00) · Cinco euros (£5.00)

1. Match these items. Write the Spanish word next to the English: 1. Apple, 2. Bread, 3. Cheese, 4. Milk. (4 marks)

2. Rosa buys an apple for £1.00 and bread for £2.00. How much does she spend in total? Write your answer in Spanish: 'Cuesta...' (2 marks)

3. Complete the dialogue: The shopkeeper says 'Hola!' Rosa replies: 'Hola, yo quiero comprar _____ (the bread) por favor.' (2 marks)

4. If cheese costs £3.00 and milk costs £2.00, what is the total in pounds? (2 marks)

5. Rosa wants to be polite. What Spanish word for 'thank you' should she say when she leaves? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a colourful market stall with Rosa the parrot holding a basket. Label at least three items in the basket using their Spanish names.



Extension challenge: Imagine you have £10.00 to spend at the market. Write a list of three items you would buy and calculate the total cost in pounds. Write the names of the items in Spanish.
