

Rosa's Market Adventure: A Spanish Shopping Diary

Learning objective: To use Spanish vocabulary related to food and prices in a shopping context, and to practise asking and answering questions about costs using £ currency.

Rosa the parrot is helping her friends at the local market. Use this template to plan your own shopping trip. Imagine you are buying three items from the market, record their names in Spanish, and calculate the total cost in pounds (£). Use the word bank to help you with your sentences.

Word bank: ¿Cuánto cuesta? · Cuesta... · la manzana (apple) · el plátano (banana) · el pan (bread) · la leche (milk) · el queso (cheese) · muchas gracias

1. Item 1: Write the name of your first item in Spanish and how much it costs in £. (2 marks)

2. Item 2: Write the name of your second item in Spanish and how much it costs in £. (2 marks)

3. Item 3: Write the name of your third item in Spanish and how much it costs in £. (2 marks)

4. The Total: Add up the cost of all three items. Write the total in a full sentence in Spanish (e.g., 'El total es...'). (3 marks)

5. Polite Phrases: Write a short dialogue where you ask the shopkeeper the price of an item and say thank you in Spanish. (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Try to write a sentence describing the colour of your items in Spanish (e.g., 'La manzana es roja').
