

Rosa's Weather Report: El Tiempo

Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish vocabulary to describe different weather conditions.

Rosa the parrot is preparing to fly across Spain to visit her friends. Look at the weather symbols for different cities and match them to the correct Spanish phrases. Then, help Rosa write her weather report by filling in the blanks.

1. Match the weather symbol description to the Spanish phrase: The sun is shining brightly. (1 mark)

2. Match the weather symbol description to the Spanish phrase: It is raining. (1 mark)

3. Match the weather symbol description to the Spanish phrase: It is cloudy. (1 mark)
