

Zara's Easter Design Studio

Learning objective: To explore patterns, symmetry, and decorative design inspired by the Easter season.

Zara the zebra loves finding patterns in nature! Use this design template to plan your own Easter-themed art project. Think about the shapes, colours, and textures you want to use for your final masterpiece. Be creative and remember to show how you have used symmetrical patterns in your work.

Word bank: Symmetry · Pattern · Texture · Vibrant · Contrast · Intricate · Geometric · Decorative

1. Design Concept: Describe the main object you are choosing to decorate (e.g., an egg, a basket, or a greeting card) and explain why you chose this shape. (2 marks)

2. Pattern Planning: Zara loves stripes and spots! Describe the specific patterns you will use on your design and where you will place them to create balance. (2 marks)

3. Colour Palette: List the colours you have chosen for your project. Explain how these colours will work together to create a bright, spring-like feel. (2 marks)

4. Technique Choice: What art materials will you use (e.g., watercolours, felt tips, or collage)? Explain how these materials will help you achieve the effect you want. (2 marks)

5. Reflection: Look at your design plan. How have you used symmetry to make your art look neat and professional? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Once your plan is complete, create your final artwork on a separate piece of paper. Present your work to a partner and explain one reason why you are proud of your pattern choices.
