Learning objective: To recall and retell a Christmas story, using descriptive language and imaginative details.

Read a Christmas story, then use this report to tell your friends about it. Imagine you are a book reviewer, and write a report about the story you read. Include the title of the story, the main characters, the setting, and the exciting events that happened.

Write a short report about the Christmas story you read, including the title of the story, the main characters, and the setting.

1. What is the title of the Christmas story you read? (1 mark)

2. Who are the main characters in the story? Describe their personalities and what they do. (2 marks)

3. What is the setting of the story? Describe the time and place where the story takes place. (2 marks)

4. What are some exciting events that happen in the story? Describe what happens and how the characters feel. (3 marks)

5. What do you think makes the story Christmas-themed? (1 mark)

6. If you were to illustrate the story, what would you draw and why? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of a festive Christmas scene from the story, and explain what's happening in the picture.



Extension challenge: Write a short poem or rhyme about the Christmas story, using at least three descriptive words from the word bank.
