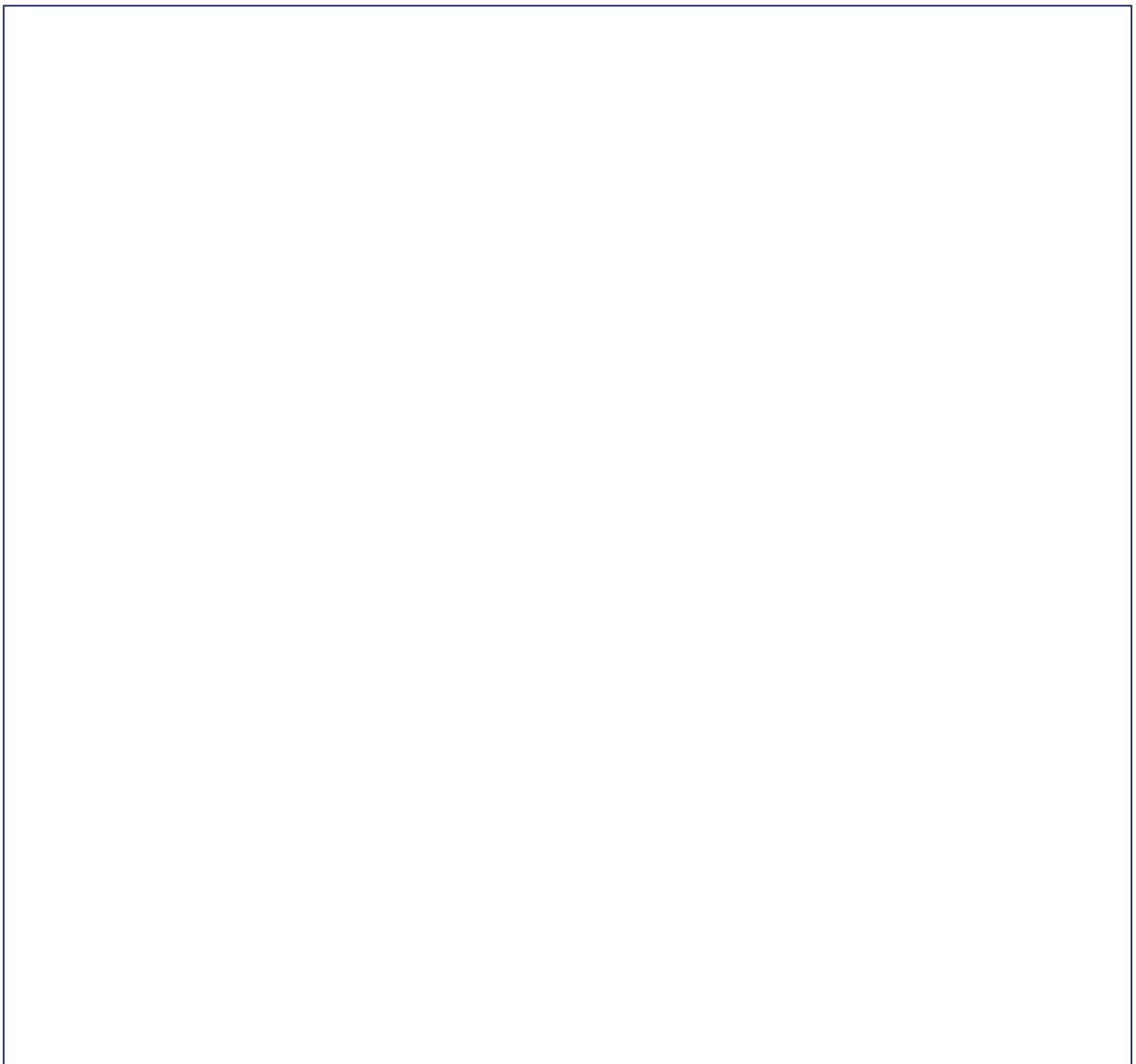


The Storyteller's Garden

Learning objective: To use descriptive language and sensory details to enhance creative writing.

Colour in the scene below, then complete the labelling tasks to help you think about how to use descriptive language in your own creative writing.

Colour this: A whimsical garden scene featuring Pip the caterpillar sitting on a large, velvety leaf of a giant sunflower.
